

**Materials List  
For  
Betty Busby Workshop  
Multi Media**

Students will be exploring many different **Multi-Media Materials** in the class. The instructor (Betty) encourages the student to bring any artist materials they might be interested in working with.

**Class includes the following:**

Sample(s) of each non-wovens sufficient to execute all of the class projects. Additional material will be available in the class for purchase, depending on supply.

One yard of 8mm silk habotal.

Use of the instructor's fabric paints. Students may also bring their own, including Dye-Na-Flow, Setasilk, Lumiere or other fabric paints.

**You need bring these materials and tools:**

Sharp scissors.

Pins.

Cutting mat and small rotary cutter. Optional is an Xacto knife.

At least one yard of a fusible of your choice. Misty Fuse is recommended.

Latex gloves.

Minimum two yards white or light-colored cotton, or other material (PFD not required).

Container for water to rinse brushes.

Water sprayer.

Parchment paper or Teflon sheet (preferred).

Four fat quarters of white or light-colored material, can be any material, including synthetics.

Set of acrylic paints, any brand.

Brushes; recommended are 1" chipped brushes and large (size 8-10) round bristle brushes meant for acrylic paint. The instructor recommends buying chipping brushes at a hardware store, usually found in the bottom bins, the brushes are a dollar or so each.

***Note: Do not bring a sewing machine. No sewing machines are necessary for this class.***

**Optional items the student can bring:**

Gallon ziplock bags to take home completed projects and treasures.

Apron or at least wear painting clothes.

Extra fabric to paint. Some of the techniques work best on silk habatol, but the student can bring cottons or even synthetics too.

Other media to bring, if the student has them, and would like to explore are; Prismacolor colored pencils, fabric paints such as Lumiere, Derwent, Inktense pencils and markers.

***Note: The instructor does not use or recommend regular watercolors or watercolor pencils, and water soluble, oil or regular pastels, and regular oil paint.***

**Venue to provide:**

Iron(s) and ironing area.

Protective covering for work area.

Sink and running water for cleanup and cleanup supplies (paper towels).
